Paint Paris Green at the Saint Patrick's Day Parade on Sunday, March 17th at 13h

Paris, 08.03 - For only the second time ever, Paris will have its very own St. Patrick's Day Parade. Organised by the Irish in France Association, the parade will leave from the Centre Culturel Irlandais, 5 rue des Irlandais at 13h for a short route around the Pantheon, before returning to the Centre Culturel via one of Paris' most famous streets, la rue Mouffetard.

Leading the parade will be Minister John Halligan TD, Minister of State for Training, Skills, Innovation, Research and Development, Ireland's Ambassador to France, H.E.
